Welcome

Tricky Women Tricky Realities is more than just a film festival; it is a cultural organisation that highlights the transformative power of storytelling from the periphery of mainstream power dynamics. We champion animation by female and/or genderqueer filmmakers because this medium creates new tools of expression, expanding our vocabulary to engage and articulate tricky realities. Feminist forms of film presentation challenge hegemonic storytelling and weave these stories into the larger cultural narrative. We are proud to foster a community at the intersection of creativity and gender justice. The cinematic landscape is richer and more vibrant when diverse perspectives are not only welcomed but actively celebrated.

In the interest of re-writing a film history that typically privileges the contributions of men, this year's edition features a retrospective dedicated to Isabel Herguera. The Basque filmmaker is known for pushing the boundaries of experimental animation in terms of both technique and storytelling. The Austrian premiere of her feature-length debut, SULTANA'S DREAM, will be accompanied by a Best Practice lecture to trace the films' evolution from idea to exhibition, at the intersection of life and fiction.

Katrin Rothe's second animated feature film, JOHNNY & ME, is our second Austrian premiere. Partly animated at the ASIFA Austria studio in Vienna, the film takes us on a journey through time with a young graphic designer and John Heartfield, who pioneered the use of art as a political weapon.

Our Best Practice international forum will also feature lectures that challenge the border between documentary and animation and look at how new technology is complicating (or expanding) our relationship to reality, focusing on the potential of the im/possible.

Expanding the scope of how tricky realities can be reflected to us, the festival presents a virtual reality program and exhibits augmented-reality objects at various places in Vienna. From technocratic interventions in the public imagination to cyberfeminism and the transformative potential of extended realities, we see how the four walls of the frame have dissolved and morphed into a new cinematic landscape that blurs the binaries between individual and algorithm.

Political, physical and virtual realities collide in HAUNTED LANDSCAPES at Bildraum 07. Valentina Berthelon's exhibition looks at the uprising against neoliberal oppression in Chile. She captures the collective moments of catharsis and victory, primarily from the perspective of women who led the struggle.

Join us as we celebrate those who mobilise animation to challenge asymmetrical power dynamics and provide new avenues for us to acknowledge and navigate tricky realities.

Our special thanks go to the filmmakers, our jurors, our advisory board, our donors, our sponsors, our partner institutions, business and media partners, and all those who support us and make our festival possible!

Graphic designer Stefanie is stuck in a rut. Between advertising projects and commissioned works, her creative efforts seem futile and meaningless. Things change when she goes to see an exhibition and discovers the works of German photomontage artist, Dadaist and antifascist John Heartfield. Like Alice falling down the rabbit hole. Stefanie miraculously finds herself transported to the basement studio of this pioneer of political photomontage. And on top of that, the artist himself is present as well in the form of an animated figure. Heartfield's collages scathingly mocked war, fascism and, most of all, the rise of Nazism in 1930s Germany. Inspired by his eventful life, which feels like an odyssey through the turmoil of the 20th century, a dialogue unfolds between Stefanie and Heartfield about the purpose and meaning and, most importantly, the political power of art. The film is terrifyingly topical - in view of the growing threat of far-right extremism, Heartfield himself says in a goosebump moment: "Facism: Do you even know what that means? Here they are again." An absolute must-see!

Director Katrin Rothe will speak about the making and the background of her film at the Best Practice forum. Collages with elements from the film will also be on display on the mezzanine floor of Metro cinema during the festival.



Valentina Berthelon and Catalina Ibáñez



Tricky Women Tricky Realities brings together works by Valentina Berthelon and Catalina Ibáñez at Bildraum 07 – this year's focus is on Chile.

In HAUNTED LANDSCAPES, Valentina Berthelon looks at Plaza de la Dignidad in Santiago de Chile, the epicentre of the 2019-20 protests where women stood up against machista violence, femicides and unequal living and working conditions for months. The hoods they wore became a symbol of equality; at Bildraum 07, Valentina Berthelon has transferred them into an intervention together with virtual portraits. Together with other Chilean artists she has also created a host of hybrid identities who retake Plaza de la Dignidad to capture the moments of victory and collective catharsis from a predominantly female perspective. Catalina Ibáñez presents her animated film CUERPAS QUE LUCHAN/BODIES THAT FIGHT. It tells the story of Matilde Urzúa, who actively participated in a feminist protest performance in 2018. 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
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


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
